Welcome to Our Sacred Arts Community!

When you book a ticket for Sacred Arts Camp (SAC), you're joining our wonderful community for the year.

As a member of this community, you help make SAC a safe, happy, and healthy place by following these Community Agreements. These guidelines reflect the spirit of our Camp, and we're so grateful to have you with us!

As a member of our community, you agree to:

Arrive & Depart on Time

Please arrive after 12 noon on the first Friday and depart by sunset on the final Saturday.

Stay for the Whole Week

Being together for the full week helps build trust, friendship, and a meaningful shared experience.

We understand that life can be unpredictable, but we ask that you commit to the entire duration of Camp.

Not Have Visitors On-Site

To maintain the intimacy of our community, visitors are not permitted once Camp begins.

The gate will close to new arrivals on Sunday.

If you need to meet someone (e.g., a child being picked up), please arrange to meet them at the gate and inform the gate crew. Visitors will not be allowed onto the site.

Leave Your Dogs at Home

Although we love dogs, they are not permitted on site.

Being Photographed

Our official photographer will take pictures during the week for promotional use.

If you or your children prefer not to be photographed, please inform the Holding Group.

Unless we hear otherwise, we will assume we have your consent.

Not Play Electronic Music

We cherish the natural soundscape of Camp, so please avoid using electronic music devices.

Use Phones Mindfully

If you need to use your phone, please step over to the car park or leave the site to help keep Camp peaceful.

We do not provide phone-charging facilities, so come prepared with a full battery or your own charging solution.

Keep an Eye on Your Kids

Parents and carers are responsible for their children and teenagers throughout the week, even when they're out of sight.

Please stay aware of where they are and what they're doing—this keeps everyone safe and happy.

Refrain from Using Alcohol or Drugs

As part of our community ethos, we ask that you avoid alcohol and drugs during Camp.

They can impact the experience for others, so please also discuss this with any young people you bring.

Respect Quiet Hours

Please keep noise to a minimum after 11 pm and before 7 am so everyone can rest.

Tents aren't soundproof, so your consideration is appreciated!

Book a Space for Your Live-In Vehicle

If you're bringing a camper van or caravan, please let us know at the time of booking.

Spaces are limited and allocated along the edge of the field.

If you haven't pre-booked, we cannot guarantee you a space.

If you are arriving in a live-in vehicle, please aim to arrive as early as possible so the Gate Dome team can help you park correctly.

Join Us in Karma Yoga

Everyone aged 13 and up is asked to join two work sessions during the week—whether in the café, assisting with children's activities, chopping wood, or maintaining our compost toilets.

When you arrive, we'll help match you with a task that suits you.

Recycle & Take Your Waste Home

We provide recycling and composting bins, but all other waste—including non-recyclables—must be taken home.

Please aim to bring items with minimal packaging to reduce waste.

Enjoy Open Fires & Care for the Land

We love the land and ask that you care for it with us.

Fires are allowed only in designated, dug fire pits.

Please preserve the turf (sods) removed for the pit, water them during Camp, and ensure they are replaced afterwards.

Commit to Upholding a Safe Camp

Your safety and wellbeing are our top priority—and you play an important role in that.

If you have any safety or safeguarding concerns, please speak to the Camp Safeguarding Officer or a member of the Holding Group.

It's essential that we all speak up to ensure everyone feels safe and cared for.

If you are unable to agree to any of them, or if you would like to suggest additions, please let us know.
